

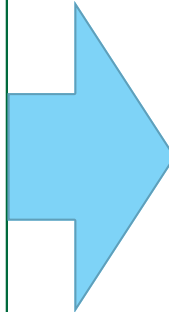
YJC: Summer Program



Step 1: Getting Started

Is the **Summer Program** right for you?

- Review your eligibility
 - ⇒ 15-18 years old at time of registration
 - ⇒ Ontario Resident
 - ⇒ Legally able to work in Canada
 - ⇒ High school students intending to stay in/return to high school or access post-secondary education after their job placement
- Meet with our staff to ensure program fit and to get registered!

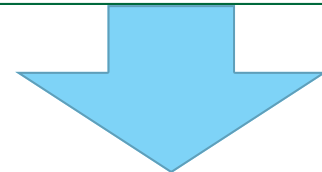


Step 2: Earn While You Learn

Earn money while attending workshops and activities designed to help you get hired.

- Goal setting & Career exploration
- Budgeting
- Managing your social media profile
- Resume building & Effective job search
- Acing the interview
- On the job skills & Employer expectations

Participants are paid minimum wage for attendance during the **20-30 hours** of program.



Step 4: Staying Connected

After you complete the program we will keep in touch to see how you're doing.

Opportunities to maximize your success include:

- Continued coaching or mentoring support
- Exploring education and training goals
- Becoming a mentor for others
