Individual sessions encourage speech, musical, cognitive, emotional, behavioural, and motor skill development, group sessions address the same skills as individual sessions plus foster social skill building.

Who: Music therapy can engage participants of all ages and ability levels. Music can be a motivator for children /youth who have a difficult time staying focused, sitting still, or engaging in other styles of therapy or learning. Music therapy can also compliment the work being done in school or other therapies and work towards the same goals.

No prior musical experience is necessary to participate in Firefly Music Therapy.

Music Therapy programs are facilitated by an accredited music therapist who has extensive experience working with clients with a wide range of needs.
